WAM will offer artmaking activities with special protocols:


- ➡ All art activities will be modified to ensure a safe and healthy environment for kids.
- ▼ Face masks are required for children, except infants and kids in strollers.
- Participants will be spaced at least six feet apart for social distancing.
- ♥ Participants will be clustered to restrict mixing.
- ♥ Immediate contact will be strenuously avoided.
- ♥ Supplies and materials will not be shared.
- WAM will provide hand sanitizers in the Living Room, Art Studio, and select areas in the museum. During programs, visitors will be asked to clean table stations after their session and before the next group. These spaces with high-touch locations will be cleaned by WAM staff four times during public hours—or every two hours.
- WAM will also continue to monitor the current local health and safety guidelines and make any changes or cancellations as needed to ensure safety.
